GARY BORN is Chair of the International Arbitration Practice Group of the law firm WilmerHale and is widely regarded as the world's preeminent authority on international commercial arbitration and international litigation. Ranked for more than 20 years as one of the world's leading international arbitration advocates and as the leading arbitration practitioner in London, Professor Born has participated in more than 600 international arbitrations, including four of the largest ICC arbitrations and several of the most significant ad hoc arbitrations in recent history.
