JOSEPH STIGLITZ

Joseph Stiglitz was awarded the Nobel Prize in economics for his analyses of markets with asymmetric information, and he was a lead author of the 1995 Report of the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change, which shared the 2007 Nobel Peace Prize. In 2011, Time named Stiglitz one of the 100 most influential people in the world

Shoshana Zuboff is a Harvard professor, philosopher and social psychologist. She is the author of many books dealing with the topics of surveillance capitalism and digital revolution, as well as exploring the historical emergence of psychological individuality, and the conditions for human development. In addition to her academic work, she is also involved in key social projects and a recognized public speaker.

ROBERT KEOHANE

Robert O. Keohane is one of the most prominent academics working in the field of International Relations. He is a leading figure within neoliberal institutionalism, an approach to international relations that emphasizes the use of international institutions by states to further their interests through cooperation. In 2009 he was named the most influential scholar of the preceding 20 years in the field of international relations by the journal Foreign Policy.

ROBERT POLLIN

Robert Pollin is University Professor of Economics and Co-Director of the Political Economy Research Institute (PERI) at the University of Massachusetts-Amherst. He is also the founder and President of PEAR (Pollin Energy and Retrofits). He has worked as a consultant for both public sector and numerous non-governmental organizations on various aspects of building high-employment green and sustainable economies.

J. Ann Tickner is an Anglo-American professor and theorist of feminist international relations. She was the first feminist theorist of international relations to head the International Studies Association. Most feminist theory of I.R. takes a strongly deconstructivist approach to knowledge, arguing that the theories reflect the social gender positioning of their authors; they therefore questioned positivist ("scientific") methods for obscuring the gender politics of knowledge construction.



J. ANN TICKNER

Harriet Lamb is the Chief Executive Officer of Ashden, an organisation that supports sustainable energy enterprises from around the world. Her career builds on campaigning for fair trade, equity, and civil society development. From 2001 to 2012 she was the Executive Director of the United Kingdom Fairtrade Foundation, and in 2012 she became Chief Executive Officer of the global standards, certification and producer development organisation, Fairtrade International.

MAXIMO TORERO

Maximo Torero Cullen is the Chief Economist of the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) since 2019. Prior to joining FAO, he was the World Bank Group Executive Director for Argentina, Bolivia, Chile Paraguay, Peru and Uruguay. Mr. Torero had also led the Division of the Markets, Trade, and Institutions at the International Food Policy Research Institute (IFPRI).

Carlotta Sami has been working for over fifteen years in the field of international relations, human rights and humanitarian intervention. In 2012 she was General Director of Amnesty International in Italy. Since January 2014 she is Spokesperson of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) Regional Office for Southern Europe.



CARLOTTA SAMI

Grammenos Mastrojeni is an Italian diplomat and professor of Environment and Gestrategy in various universities around the world and has dedicated himself for over 20 years to the theme of climate change. Since 2019 he has been Deputy Secretary General for Energy and Climate Action at Union for the Mediterranean, based in Barcelona, and President of UN Mountains.
